If you have sloping fields in your operation, terraces are a good water and soil management structure to adopt to minimize soil erosion and conserve soil moisture on steep slopes. The kinds of terraces that can be used (narrow-based, broad-based, or terrace channels) are flexible and can be adapted to your needs and the soil type, and they can be spaced according to the potential for erosion and equipment considerations.

The early constant grade terrace, first constructed during the 1930s and early 1940s, was and continues today as an excellent erosion control device. It is relatively easy to design and lay out in the field. It can be constructed using farm equipment. Grass turn rows or brush along the banks of a ditch or fence row often provide outlets.

To accommodate farm machinery and farming operations, design cropland terraces with long gentle curves. When multiple terraces are used in a field, design the terraces to be as parallel to one another as practicable. Capacity. Design terraces to have enough capacity to control the runoff from a 10-year frequency, 24-hour storm without overtopping.
